









PIZZA PINWHEEL RECEPIE

Ingredients

- 1 package refrigerated pizza crust or puff pastry.
- Pizza sauce
- Ham
- Mozzarella Cheese
- Pizza toppings of choice

Method

- Lightly grease a baking sheet.
 Set aside.
- Unroll a pack of refrigerated pizza crust or puff pastry onto a cutting board.
- Spread a light layer of pizza sauce over the dough.
- Sprinkle with ham and any other pizza toppings.
- Spread mozzarella over the top.
- Carefully roll the dough to make a log shape.
- Pinch the sides and using a pizza cutter or knife, slice into individual pieces.
- Bake at 180*C until the cheese is melted, and rolls are a light golden brown.
